Frank Stewart is the President and Chief Operating Officer of the American Association of Blacks in Energy (AABE). Founded in 1977, AABE is a membership organization of nearly 1700 professionals from nearly all aspects of the energy industries. AABE's mission is to serve as a voice for minority, fixed, and low income persons in national energy policy. Mr. Stewart was a Senior Executive with the United States Department of Energy for more than thirty years during which time he served as Deputy Assistant Secretary and Acting Assistant Secretary for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy. In addition to his work with the AABE, he is a member of the Board of Directors of the StEPP Foundation, a member of the Board of Directors of the National Low-Income Energy Coalition, and a member of the Board of Advisors of the International Center for Appropriate and Sustainable Technologies. Additionally, Mr. Stewart is a member of the Environmental Protection Agency's National Advisory Council on Environmental Policies and Technologies.
